## Our Project

**Our project is aimed** at people living in poverty in the East Rand area of Gauteng Province, South Africa.

In association with Siyabonga, a registered non-profit organisation which provides courses in life skills and educational programs for improving employment opportunities, we will assist those people who are unemployed and struggling to provide the basics of life for their families.

## How?

The process is one of training and skills development, currently in:

- fashion design and clothing manufacture using a sewing machine;
- welding of steel components;
- the baking of confectionary and bread.

The outcome will be that these disadvantaged people will have been taught skills that will enable them to earn a living sufficient to support themselves and their families.
